
Figueroa Property Remediation and Park Project Overview

- Location of former Figueroa Pump Station (1908-1959)
- Property had been vacant and unused since 1959
- Soil contamination detected at the property

Remedial Site Clean up of the Former Figueroa Pump Station Site including:

- Removal of lead, diesel range organics, motor oil contaminated soil
- Demolition and removal of former concrete reservoir and pit
- Backfill with certified clean soil
- Remediation shall meet Residential Screening Standards





Total Material

Excavated: 10,169 tons

Total Backfill Used:

12,454 tons









Final Post Excavation Report -

Based on a comparison of applicable risk-based Screening Levels (SLs) to the concentrations of residual Constituents of Potential Concerns (COPCs) in soil at the Site, the remediation excavation and soil removal activities have removed or reduced the concentrations of the COPCs to an acceptable level for the proposed redevelopment."





Figueroa Property Remediation and Park Project Overview

- Property licensed to the Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks to develop, operate, and maintain the park
- Proposed elements of the park included pathways, seating elements, shade structures, exercise stations, and children's play equipment

Figueroa Property Remediation and Park Project Justification

- Property has been vacant and unused for over 6 decades
- No immediate needs or plans to utilize property
- Infill development opportunity in coordination with LARAP and Council District No. 9
- LARAP will operate and maintain the property

- Contributes to environmental health and wellbeing to a disadvantaged community


